

Impact of your gifts—highlights



WILDLIFE

- Southern Environmental Law Center secured a ban on spotlight hunting coyotes within the five-county Red Wolf Recovery Area. This is one of the crucial steps in protecting the endangered red wolves who are often confused with coyotes.
- NC Coastal Land Trust worked with legislators on a successful new law to protect the endangered venus flytrap from poachers. Venus flytraps are found in the wild in one tiny part of the world, an area roughly 60 miles around Wilmington, NC.



NC'S NATURAL HERITAGE

- NC Wildlife Federation hosted Great Outdoors University, a conservation-based experiential education program for children and teens 6-18 years old who have limited opportunity to explore the natural world. In 2014, 70 day trips served over 2,700 participants.
- NC Coastal Federation completed a 1,350 acre wetland restoration project, diverting agricultural runoff away from the Pamlico Sound and Alligator River by using the landscape to filter water, recharge the wetlands, and improve habitat.



HEALTH & BASIC RIGHTS

- Clean Air Carolina designed and installed an Ozone Garden in McDowell Nature Preserve in Meckleburg County. This high profile ozone garden will serve as a way to teach the community how air pollution impacts all living things.
- Tar River Land Conservancy permanently protected 117 acres of wetlands and forest one mile upstream of Falls Lake near Raleigh. The project included clean up of a 600,000 gallon abandoned hog waste lagoon and replanting the area in native hardwood trees. This eliminated the threat of wastewater discharge into Robertson Creek which feeds Falls Lake, the City of Raleigh's primary drinking water supply.
